A pair of Chelsea leaf shaped dishes, each with green glazed loop handle, painted in coloured enamels with sprays of flowers and leaves, the veining picked out in puce, the underside moulded in relief with strawberries and scrolling leaves, picked out in red, green and yellow, brown line rims, 8 3/4" long, circa 1755, one with red anchor mark
