A Lowestoft saucer, painted in underglaze blue with a simple flower spray, within a roundel, the border with three roundels of Chinese river landscapes, on a crisply moulded flower head and diaper panelled ground, the rim painted with a 'key and cell' band, 4 3/4" diameter, circa 1765, blue painted numeral 8 and dot mark inside the footrim
