An extremely rare Worcester sauce ladle, with round bowl and moulded handle, painted in underglaze blue with the K'ang Hsi Lotus Pattern, 6 3/4" long, circa 1770, blue painted Chinese emblem mark

Worcester blue and white sauce ladles are of the greatest rarity. See Branyan, French and Sandon, I.E.33, for a larger example, painted with The Ladle Sprays Pattern, then the only recorded Worcester blue and white sauce ladle
