A Chelsea round ecuelle and cover, with barbed rim, the knop formed as a naturalistically painted apple, on a stem with leaves, the two leaf shaped handles picked out in yellow and turquoise, finely painted in coloured enamels with sprays of flowers and leaves, and scattered flowers, brown line rim, 8" diameter overall, circa 1755, red anchor mark
