A rare Worcester oval dish

A rare Worcester oval dish, painted in coloured enamels with a butterfly and a caterpillar, the pale yellow ground basket moulded border picked out in puce, the two pierced leaf and stem shaped handles very finely painted with veining, 12" wide, circa 1770, no mark
