A rare Ginori biscuit porcelain cabinet cup, finely modelled as a head and shoulders portrait of Elisa Baciocchi, her plaited hair forming the loop handle, gilt interior, 3 5/8" high, circa 1810, no mark

Maria Anna Elisa Baciocchi, Grand Duchess of Tuscany (1777-1820), the sister of Napoleon Bonaparte, an Imperial French Princess, who also held the titles of Princess of Lucca and Piombino. She married Felice Pasquale Baciocchi in 1797
