Maria Anna Elisa Baciocchi, Grand Duchess of Tuscany (1777-1820), the sister of Napoleon Boneparte, an Imperial French Princess, who also held the titles of Princess of Lucca and Piombino. She married Felice Pasquele Baciocchi in 1797
