A rare Worcester oval chestnut basket, pierced cover and stand, painted in coloured enamels in the London atelier of James Giles, moulded overall with a flower head trellis design, picked out in blue and yellow, the green glazed twig loop handles and loop knop with brightly coloured applied flower and leaf terminals, the centre of the stand painted with a cut pomegranate, plums and a peach, gilt line rim, 10" wide, circa 1768, no mark
