A rare Worcester fluted tea cup and saucer, the cup with ear shaped handle, finely painted in 'dry blue' enamel with flowers and leaves, within turquoise and gilt entwined leaf scrolls, the border with turquoise 'shagreen' panels, and purple ground panels of flowers, within gilt 'C' scrolls, suspending turquoise and black laurel swags, circa 1775, no mark

This is a rare example of the Reagan pattern on Worcester tea wares
