In 'Sevres' style, each finely painted in coloured enamels to one side with two winged putti, and the reverse painted by William Cook with a spray of flowers, fruits and leaves, within oval raised paste gilded flower and scroll cartouches, on a bright green ground, on square base, 10 3/4" high, circa 1850-55, conjoined CBD marks in gilt
