

BY APPOINTMENT TO HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN SUPPLIERS OF 18th CENTURY PORCELAINS



A very rare Worcester dish

A very rare Worcester oval dish, painted in coloured enamels with a spray of flowers and leaves, the boldly basket moulded border with pale blue ground, and two leaf moulded handles, finely picked out in brown, yellow and shades of green, 11 1/2" wide, circa 1758, no mark

Provenance; Acquired from Simon Spero, 29th November 2004, 'An extremely rare Worcester leaf moulded dish...the palette seems to be hithero unrecorded'

We do not record another example of this pale blue ground on Worcester of this period in our archive
