A fine pair of Chelsea two branch candelabra, each in the form of a cherub, he with a quiver of arrows, and she with a basket of flowers, and each garlanded with flowers, their robes decorated in turquoise, puce and gilt, the scroll moulded branches each supporting a pierced scone, on shell and scroll moulded base, picked out in gilt, 11" high, circa 1765, gold anchor marks
