A Worcester fluted lozenge shaped dish, brilliantly painted in coloured enamels in the London atelier of James Giles with a peach, a cut pear and redcurrants, the border with two pairs of confronting birds in branches, and two birds in flight, gilt line rim, 10 1/4" wide, circa 1768, no mark
