An exceptional pair of Chamberlain's Worcester campana shaped ice pails, covers and liners, each with pinecone knob and two gilt satyr mask and vine loop handles, brilliantly painted in coloured enamels with a continuous band of flowers and leaves. Including passion flowers, on a shaded band, on a yellow ground, and with gilt gadrooned bands, on round marbled foot, 12 5/8" high, circa 1825, each signed 'P. Bradley' in purple beneath
